

Keeping your site complaint

We want to be able to continue supplying your LPG so it's really important that your site is compliant.

Who needs to read this

You are responsible for making sure your site is compliant. This is especially important if:

your cylinders are not delivered by



 your cylinders are delivered by a courier or boat.

If your cylinders get delivered to a temporary location without a Location Compliance Certificate (LCC), you have 12 hours to move the cylinders.

What you need to have

Have a current Location Compliance Certificate (LCC)



Keep within the limits of your LCC



If you don't have an LCC or you are over your limit

To get an LCC contact your Compliance Certifier or see the WorkSafe list of Compliance Certifiers compliancecertifiers.worksafe.govt.nz

Ask for a new LCC with a higher limit, or reduce the number of cylinders on your site.

To get an LCC and stay compliant

Have a look at Getting a Location Compliance Certificate information sheet or go to the WorkSafe website.

Test your Emergency Response Plan every 12 months. You'll need to provide proof.

Keep within the limit of your LCC. Keep a count of the number of cylinders on your site. Use the table below as a guide.

Make sure your cylinders are in a suitable location, eg there are no drains or other openings nearby.

If there have been changes to your site or your neighbour's site, this might impact your LCC.

Sorry but...

- If you don't have an LCC or it expires, we can not supply LPG to you.
- We will **not** supply you if we think it will put you over your LCC limit.
