



Automotive LPG Price Increase June 2026 FAQs

When are the Rockgas fuel card automotive LPG prices changing?

All price changes are effective 17 June 2026. Rockgas sent letters (by email or post) notifying all cardholders of this change on 18 May 2026.

Why is the price of Rockgas fuel card automotive LPG increasing?

Ongoing conflict in the Middle East is continuing to affect global supply chains, and the cost of buying LPG has increased as a result. We're also seeing higher delivery-related costs, including diesel and AdBlue.

Alongside these external pressures, we're also experiencing higher costs to keep our automotive operations safe, reliable and fit for purpose.

Is the price increasing due to LPG running out?

No, the increase covers our higher operating costs to supply LPG.

Why would I pay more using my fuel card when the service station price is lower?

Rockgas do not control service station prices, so there will be a variance across the country when you purchase your automotive LPG.

I've not agreed to having price increases, why are you doing this?

Our standard supply terms and conditions allow us to make changes to our fees and charges from time to time. This increase is due to changes in our operating costs that we cannot continue to fully cover.
